Domini Nostri Jesu Christi, mundum laetificare dignatus es:

Praesta, quaesumus; ut per eius Genetricem Virginem

Mariam, perpetuae capiamus gaudia vitae. Per eundem

Christum Dominum nostrum. Amen.
