## **CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION SUNDAY JUNE 23<sup>RD</sup>**

### **AFTER 12.00 noon MASS**

As a person with a business or residence along the route of the procession we invite you to honour The Blessed Sacrament with an altar, some flowers or by whatever means you see fit yourself. We appreciate your co-operation on this every year.

### **ORDER OF THE PROCESSION:**

Cross Bearer/Town Band/People/Choir/' Do This in Memory' /First Holy Communion Children 2019.

### **THE PROCESSION ROUTE:**

Starts at James St., via South Mall, to The Fairgreen for Benediction, on to Mill St., Shop St., James St., and return to the Church, entering by the front door for General Blessing & finish with singing of 'Faith of Our Fathers'

### **THE FORMAT OF THE PROCESSION:**

A decade or two of the Rosary will be recited while people are assembling, led from the altar, the third decade at The Fairgreen and fourth & fifth as the procession proceeds along Mill St. The Town Band will play along South Mall to the Fairgreen. St. Mary's Choir will sing at the Fairgreen along with the band and all people together when The Rosary is over and as the procession is nearing the church.

Holy Communion children to collect baskets from Carrowbeg House between 11.30 a.m. & 11.40 a.m. (children need to supply their own petals). Assemble outside the Parish Centre in front of James St. door after Communion at 12.00 noon Mass.

- Choir to assemble at James St. gate @ 12.30
- Band assemble @ Carrowbeg House @ 11.30
- Stewards to collect Hi-Vis vests from Carrowbeg House at 11.30 a.m.
- Guard of Honour to collect gloves /arm bands from Carrowbeg House at 11.30 a.m. Assemble at James St @ 12.30p.m.
- People are asked to leave the Church via the Main door.
- Two stewards are to be in position at James St door to keep exit clear for The Blessed Sacrament.
