REGINA CAELI:

The Easter Prayer Regina Caeli (Queen of Heaven) traditionally replaces The Angelus during the Easter Season, from Holy Saturday to Pentecost.

Latin Text:

Regina Caeli, Laetare, alleluia:
Quia quem meruisti portare, alleluia,
Resurrexit, sicut dixit, alleluia,
Ora pro nobis Deum, alleluia,
Gaude et Laetare, Virgo Maria, alleluia.
Quia surrexit Dominus vere, alleluia.

Oremus. Deus, qui per resurrectionem Filii tui, Domini Nostri Jesu Christi, mundum laetificare dignatus es: Praesta, quaesumus; ut per eius Genetricem Virginem Mariam, perpetuae capiamus gaudia vitae. Per eundem Christum Dominum nostrum. Amen.

English Text:

O Queen of Heaven, rejoice, alleluia:
For He whom you were privileged to bear, alleluia,
Has risen, as He said, alleluia.
Pray for us to God, alleluia. Rejoice and be glad,
O Virgin Mary, Alleluia.
For the Lord has truly risen, alleluia.
