ASH WEDNESDAY

Distribution of Ashes in the Home – available to collect in the churches of the parish for as long as they are available. One envelope per household please. Ashes can be diviided at home. Blessed Ashes are a sacramental, just as holy water or blessed palm is. They can, with due reverence, be taken away and used by the faithful in a domestic environment.

The ashes blessed in the envelopes can be collected and brought home.

Please follow these instructions:

- 1. Take one sachet for your own use, or the use of your family
- 2. At a suitable moment on Ash Wednesday, or during online Mass, the household gathers in a suitable place for a time of prayer.
- 3. The following prayer is said:

O God, you ask us to turn back to you with all our hearts. We ask you now to hear our prayer as we begin this season of Lent. Pour out your blessing on us as we use this symbol of blessed ashes, So that, out of our smallness and sinfulness, We may come to be what you have called us to be; That we may live faithfully the vocation of our Baptism, And come to celebrate joy the Easter mystery.

Members of the household impose ashes on one another, in turn, saying:

Turn away from Sin and be faithful to the Gospel.

They all pray together... Our Father

Any ashes left over should be placed reverently in the garden.
